

Provisional Notice for
TOC Devon Rally,
Ringmore, 30th June – 1st July 2012

Come and enjoy the delights of rural South Devon! Adrian and Judy Bull who now live at Barnford, (previously the home of Sir Douglas Hall, where we used to meet in the 1990's) have very kindly made their paddock available for the weekend. There will be plenty of space for Trojans. If possible please leave your trailer elsewhere. Please arrive between 2.00pm and 3.00pm on Saturday for tea to be followed by a stroll through the village and supper at a nearby Inn in the evening at 7.30pm.

At 10.00am on Sunday we will gather again at Barnford paddock. It is hoped that some members of the Devon Vintage Car Club will join us for the run. Also that people from the village will come and admire the cars before you set off on a run of about 25 miles. The run will be through some of the beautiful South Hams countryside and finish for lunch at a nearby pub. The hills will not be too steep but some of the lanes are narrow; so please do make sure your car is in good fettle!

After lunch those who must will depart for home whilst others may wish to linger a little longer and enjoy the dramatic cliff walks, the deserted beaches and the splendid scenery and peace of this area. **You are strongly advised to bring OS Map 202.**

Directions to Barnford paddock, Ringmore, Nr Kingsbridge TQ7 4HW:-

Best approach is via the A38. From the North, leave at the Modbury/Ermington junction (A3121) – from the South and West leave at the Ivybridge junction - and follow signs for Modbury. Pass through Modbury on the A379 heading for Kingsbridge and after about 1.5 miles at the top of a hill turn right onto the B3392 following signs for Bigbury and St.Anne's Chapel. Keep ahead for about 2.5 miles, ignoring right turn, and then turn right at St.Anne's Chapel, following signs for Ringmore. Keep ahead, ignoring right turn and in 1 mile you reach Ringmore church on your right. Turn left here and the entrance to Barnford paddock is almost immediately on your right.

Mobile phones: Please note that generally they don't work in the village.

Petrol: there are very few petrol stations once you have passed Exeter!

Satnav: several people have been badly misled trying to get here by relying on their satnav. The above directions are recommended!!
