Coldharbour has a block of 3 toilets easily accessible. Plenty of parking for cars, vans/trailers and we can accommodate as many trojans as are interested in attending.

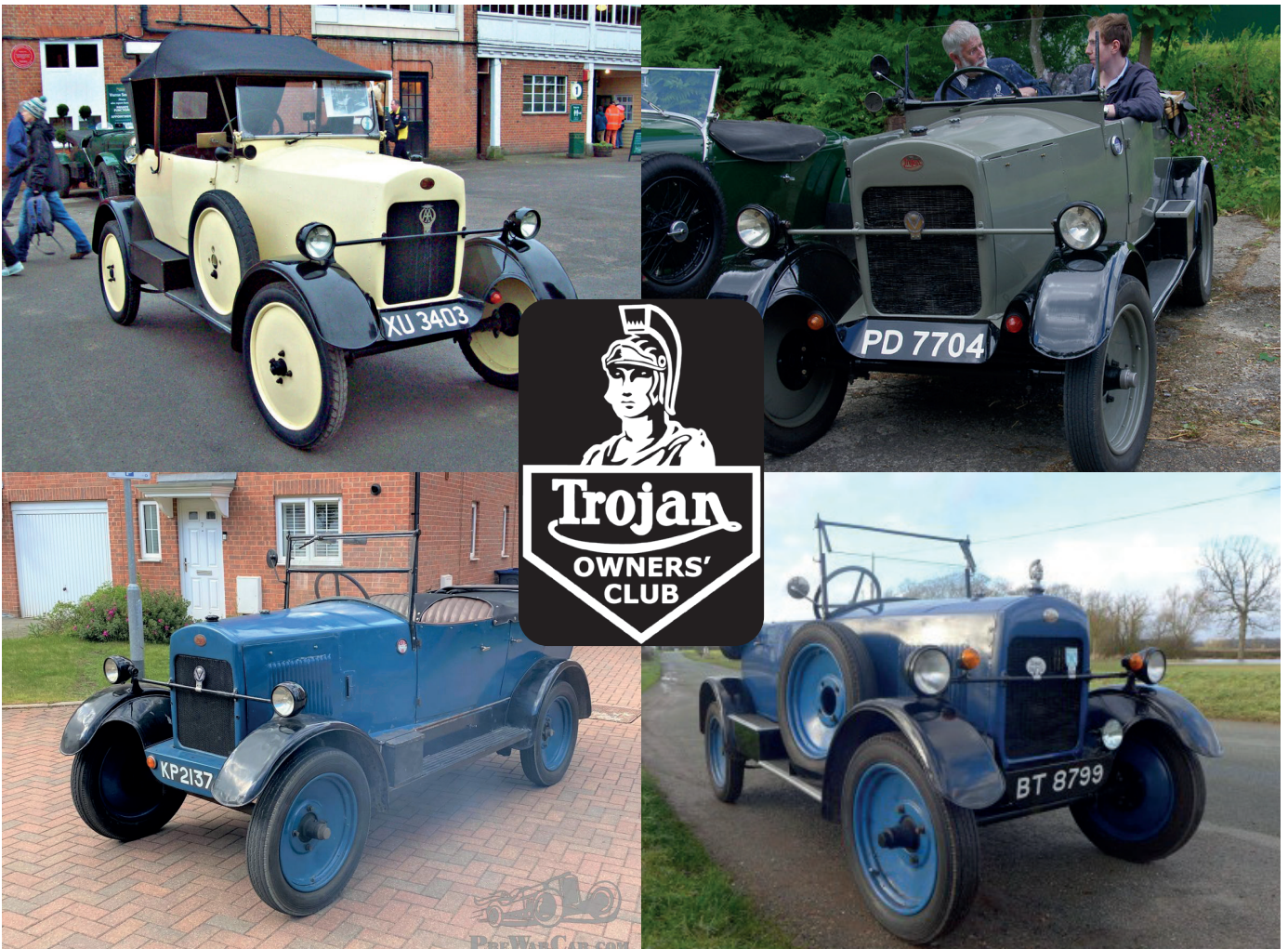

Afternoon Activities:

- During the afternoon there will be some simple driving experiences within the boundaries of Coldharbour Farm • Suggested driving activities, yet to be finalised.
 1. One up-hill trial style section – shouldn't be too difficult as hard ground in summer.
 2. One driving test with cones – timed.
